Dear Parishioners:

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year to all of you! Over 2000 years ago an angel said to shepherds, “Do not be afraid. Look, I bring you news of great joy, a joy to be shared by the whole people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord. And here is a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger” (Luke 2:10-12). I hope you have a joyful celebration of Christmas and a whole year of joy and freedom from fear because what the angel said then is still effective today; Jesus is Lord and that should be enough for us. In that vein I share this “news” with you.

This year started off as a challenge when dad ended up in the hospital during the super bowl. Eventually he had an operation on Feb. 25 to remove a cancerous tumor. He came home on Claire’s birthday and then returned to the hospital and came back home again. On Mar. 21 while doing something he loved so much, exercising, dad passed away. In last year’s letter I said that dad had turned 85 and was still going strong, but he did have some fainting spells that worried us all. He even predicted to us, I think during the thanksgiving holidays, that he would die in 2011, but we protested that he was too healthy. He knew better. He died on the death date of St. Benedict after whom he was named. We all miss him much. His funeral at the cathedral was a solemn event as 60 priests joined with all the family and friends. We buried his cremains (ashes) on Mar. 25, the solemnity of the Annunciation. Dad and I had often prayed the angelus in these past years. Grant eternal rest unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace. Amen.

As 1978 was the year of the three popes, 2011 was the year of the three associates at our church. In late Feb. Fr. Allen Breaux who started with me in 2009 moved to Duson. Fr. Randy Moreau came out of sick leave to be with us in Mar. but quickly found out it was too early to come back full force. Fr. David Hebert, who did his clinical pastoral education in Albuquerque and stayed in my brother’s rectory, was ordained on June 11 and was assigned to Scott on July 1. Each and every one has been a great addition to our parish and good rectory buddies. Speaking of rectory buddies, seminarian Neil Pettit stayed with us during the summer. He will be the next priest out of St. Mary Church in Lafayette after me; a 22 year stretch. Glad that is over and more are coming after him. Seminarian Max Harrington started a pastoral year with us Aug. 26 after he attended World Youth Day in Spain. Both of them have been great helpers in the parish.

May 1 saw the beatification of Bl. Pope John Paul II who ordained my brother and I to the priesthood. His feast day was set for Oct. 22, the date of his papal inauguration. The U.S. bishops just approved this for celebration in our country. We received a posthumous gift from him Nov. 27 with the new English translation of the Roman Missal. He had called for it in the Jubilee Year 2000 and it has finally arrived. I really like it better than the previous translation. The words are more worthy of the supreme deity.

Hamsa, my nephew, graduated from Cedar Park High School in Texas and we all attended that highlight of his life. Then he moved to Lafayette to attend UL and ended up living with mom. Then he enrolled in my RCIA program to make his confirmation. So it has been a joy to have him around. Claire, Amaan, and Nasreen are still holding down the fort in Texas.

In June I made my annual trek to Latrobe, Pa. for the Scott Hahn bible conference. We studied the gospel of Matthew which our Sunday readings have been covering this year. It’s always interesting.

June 24, the solemnity of St. John the Baptist, saw my second anniversary as pastor of Sts. Peter and Paul Church. It's a great parish and a blessing for me to be here even though I still miss all my previous parishes. Thanks to Monica and staff for all their hard work here. I couldn't do it without them. On Oct. 27 we celebrated the fiftieth anniversary of the consecration of Sts. Peter and Paul Church.

School started Aug. 17 with a new sixth grade, new teachers, and new students. It's been a great year so far. Thanks to all the faculty, administration and workers.

Our family spent the labor day weekend at the Galvez Hotel in Galveston. It would have been mom and dad's sixtieth wedding anniversary. It was a wonderful time together. The only ones who couldn't come were my niece, Lauren, and her fiancé, Marc, who were preparing for their wedding which took place at St. Mary Church in Lafayette on Nov. 19 with me as celebrant and my brother as preacher. It was a Spizale-Maniscalco match, so very Italian and all went beautifully. Matthew continues his work in Colorado and is doing well. Dave and Jan are glad all the wedding preparations are over and that all went so well.

That's a good note to end this Christmas letter on since Jesus was the fruit of God's marriage with humanity. God has come to save us and be with us so we should not fear, but be filled with joy! I hope that is your experience this Christmas and new year.
