

Food and Nutrition Services is pleased to announce NEW A La Carte items for sale in High Schools and Middle Schools. FNS participates in the USDA's National School Lunch Program and is committed to providing a cafeteria environment that promotes nutritious meals in a Christ-centered environment.

As part of USDA requirements, all food sold to students during the school day must meet **Smart Snacks Standards**. Approved snacks meet the following nutritional guidelines:

- 200 calories or less
- 10% of total calories from saturated fat or less
- The weight of all sugars must be <35% of the serving size weight
- 200 mg of sodium or less per serving
- Ingredient listing: If a grain product, must be whole grain


