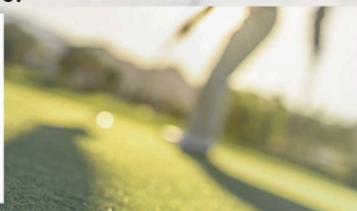

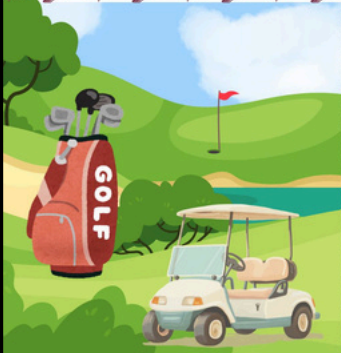

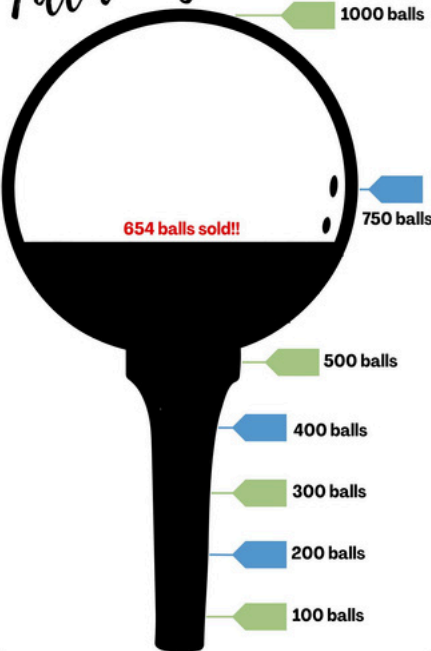
Friday, May 1st
